Chairman's Address:

The Chairman welcomed all members present to the meeting.

Minutes of the Last Meeting:

Matter's Arising:

Correspondence:

Hon. Treasurer's Report:

The Treasurer reported that all entry fees had been received, and additionally, since the last meeting £81.00 had been received from matches. There were three nominations cheques that had been sent but not cashed, which would be looked into.

The Treasurer reported that the Current Account Balance was £1,874.03 and the Reserve Account was £2,916.22.

It was agreed that the list of Charity Nominations would be published on the Website.

Hon. Referee's Secretary's Report:

The Referee's Secretary was not present at the meeting, however all games had been covered and there had not been any issued to report.

Any Other Business:

Sponsorship: Chris Hodges reported that he had been in contact with Waitrose regarding sponsorship, which would hopefully be forthcoming. Council expressed their thanks to Chris.

Trophies: The Chairman queried the trophies required for this season. It was agreed that medals would be purchased as in previous years at an approximate cost of £360.00, David would arrange.

Competition: Mick McStraw complimented the Council for the way in which the Competition was running, there always appeared to be few issues and the Competition was being run in a professional manner.
